They must have one Regular Faculty member as a Mentor (Signed Hard copies as well as soft copies by email to be submitted) who will be responsible for implementation and completion of the project. Space for working and funds will be provided for consumables.
- > There are no funds for equipments, however young innovators will be paid monthly stipend depending upon qualification and experience (Details given in Annexure).
- The Young Innovator/Faculty members will put up all projects related files through Chairperson/Director/Dean of the Department and also to take help regarding project works/audit works from their concerned Office of the department.
- The Regular Faculty members may submit proposals in collaboration with Professional Experts, Linkage tie- ups, and Industry collaborators for Innovative ideas. The candidates/companies/Resource Persons should have expertise in the proposed innovative areas and demonstrated experience with the evidence of Research publications in high impact Journals (Scopus) or Patents or Copyright or have developed Devices/Prototypes in the above given thematic areas.
- The Regular Faculty members may submit proposals for Conduct of Training Courses/ Workshops/ Conferences/ Conclave/Competition/Hackathon Modules
- The Chairpersons/Directors may submit proposals for Financial support to students/trainees/innovators for participation and travel for workshop/conference/conclave/competition/Hackathon
- > The Chairpersons/Directors may submit proposals for Financial support to students for Industrial and educational visits.
- The Young Innovator applicants (Bachelors, Masters and PhD Students of GJUS&T, Hisar), both ongoing and graduated, and Regular Faculty members may submit brief proposals for Start-up Cell or Companies in Thematic areas given above short proposals with clear cut objectives, methodology, duration of the project, budget required, financial model and deliverables to be made. They must have one Regular Faculty member as a Mentor (Signed Hard copies as well as soft copies by email to be submitted) who will be responsible for implementation and completion of the project. Space for working and funds will be provided for consumables. There are no funds for equipments.

- Young Innovators/Professionals will be paid monthly stipend depending on qualification and experience and will be provided funding for Novel

Ideas and Innovative projects @ Rs. 5 to 10 lakhs for developing Prototypes/Product Development/ Startups Novel Hand-held Devices/Point-of-Care Devices.

The duration of the proposed Innovative Ideas will be initially for Three/Six/ Nine months subject to satisfactory progress, completion of laid objectives and availability of grants from the funding agencies (up to 31st March 2022).

- 2. Output of the Innovative Proposal, skill development & training of stakeholders should be towards development of Product/device/software.
- 3. It should not be a research proposal.
- 4. Level of Innovation, learning, skill development and training.
- 5. Prospects of Commercialisation/start-up.
- 6. Societal Relevance of Innovative idea.
- 7. Timeline and budgetary requirement of the submitted proposals within the available limits.
- 8. Where private parties/companies are involved proper MoU with IPR sharing agreement to be executed.
- 9. Start-up, if any must be registered.
- 10. For innovative proposals, Association of Mentor (Regular Faculty of GJUS&T, Hisar) is mandatory.
- 11. Budgetary requirement in the proposals for major equipment cannot be met except seed money for Start-ups and ICT Infrastructure.

12. Applicants should have demonstrated experience of conducting the innovative work/training.
