



Student Feedback Analysis Report

- Out of 2831 participants 2,299 (81 %) were of the view that course content can be covered in one semester.
- 2,620 participants (93 %) agreed that in the overall structure of program course is very relevant. 1911 (68 %) participants answered that there is no overlap between the courses.
- 1940 (69 %) participants said that the recommended reading material was adequate and relevant.
- Class tests/mid-semester tests were conducted satisfactorily as per schedule as per 2553 (90 %) participants.
- 2040 (72 %) participants says that the class tests/mid-term tests were balanced in terms of difficulty level.



- 837(30%) Participants out of 2831 strongly agreed and 1337(47%) agreed that teacher complete the entire syllabus in time.
- 1133(40%) Strongly agree while 1269 (45%) participants agreed that the teachers have good subject cited knowledge.
- Teachers communicated clearly and inspired the students as per about 80% of the participants. While, 92% participants were of the view that teachers are punctual in the classes.
- More than 80 percent participants were of the view that teachers come well prepared for the class and encourages students participation and discussion in the classes.
- 66% Participants were agreed that teachers uses teaching aids handouts and provide suitable references , make presentations and conduct seminars and tutorials regularly.
- More than 80% students were agreed that teachers attitude towards students is friendly and helpful as well as available in the department.
- About 80% students were of the view that evaluation process is fair and unbiased.
