The attempt of students and teachers to collectively express themselves and working as a team has been the "mantra" of success in many events held in the university campus.


As a mark of respect to our mother tongue, "Hindi Diwas" was celebrated in the

In nutshell, Jambheshwar ji was not only a religious Guru but a great ecologist, environmentalist and a vivid social reformer.
